IIMCT has come a long way since its inception in 1995, towards its mission set by its founder, Late Maj. Gen. (R) Zulfiqar Ali Khan (Sitara Imtiaz). As a pioneering education institution with a strong focus on Islamic ethical values, IIMCT has set new standards for the Higher education in Pakistan.

Now entering in its 23rd year of operations, in year 2017-18 IIMCT has seen a transformation in the institution and has yielded a long list of land mark achievements. We have seen alhamdulillah quantum increase in our admissions and have started 6 new programs. To develop a University Campus which can provide an environment of learning for students IIMCT has bought property more than 100,000m2 in Gulberg Greens Islamabad.

## Performance Report (Overview)

Islamic International Medical College Trusts' exponential growth over the past decade is the culmination of excellence in academia as well as its extensive philanthropic endeavors that is being carried out by four fully functional healthcare service providers i.e. IIMCT Pakistan Railways Hospital, Rawalpindi, administered since 1998, Riphah International Hospital, established 2014, Islamic International Dental Hospital, Islamabad, established since 2001 and Max Health Hospital, Islamabad, started its operations in 2016. The year 2017-18 has seen IIMCT engaged in more than 56 free medical camps countrywide with over 12,000+ deserving patients being treated by our dedicated team of doctors.

The spirit of philanthropy and humanitarianism at IIMCT has been the hallmark of its achievements in the year 2017-18. By the grace of Almighty Allah, the contribution of Trust in healthcare provision for the year has benefited almost 400,000 patients providing access to a wide range of healthcare services at highly

subsidized rates to poor population. Trust spent PKR 350 million as healthcare subsidy to these hospitals.

With a vision to create a caring and integrated system of social development services that facilitates human development and helps to improve the quality of life, Riphah Social Welfare Department (RSWD) has organized 56 free medical camps treating almost 8000 patients. The third phase of Gen. (R) Zulfiqar Ali Khan Tharparker relief project has been initiated by virtue of which 35 wells has been constructed so far in 2018. To create awareness regarding healthcare and disaster preparedness, a number of awareness sessions has been conducted. IIMCT spent PKR 10.3 million on medical camps, provision of food, water and livelihood to underprivileged and poverty stricken communities in Islamabad KPK and Tkarparkar Sindh.

To enhance the healthcare services paraphernalia, new hospital bed sets have been imported to IIMCT-Pakistan Railway Hospital to cater for the needs of maximum

patients. Moreover, the establishment of a Rehab Centre in Riphah International Hospital (RIH) and Max Clinics in MaxHealth Hospitals has added considerable value in providing the best service experience through compassionate care in a patient friendly environment.

Expansion plans for IIMCT have led to considerable developments over the past few years. Some of the noticeable developments include the establishment of Swat Campus for which expedited procedures are underway to make it fully operational. Another landmark development concerning the purchase of 211 kanal of land for the purpose of constructing a new campus of Riphah International at Gulberg Greens Islamabad along with the acquisition of 48 kanal of land in the same location for building a new 600 bed hospital serving the greater purpose of quality healthcare.

In 2017-18, IIMCT has worked hard to achieve all its strategic, operational and financial goals. We have over 4,707 enrolled students studying in various disciplines and 789 students graduated this year. In year 2017-18, in pursuance of its mission, IIMCT provided scholarship worth PKR 170 million to provide the deserving students access to world class educational programs.

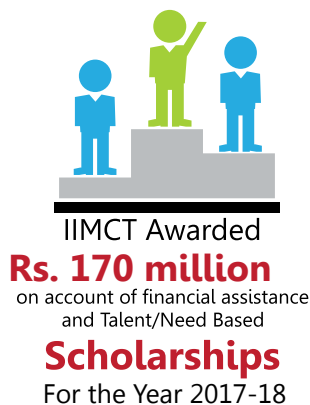
IIMCT has to continued to attract meritous students by offering high quality, accredited programs in a wide array of professional disciplines. In 2017-18 we launched 6 new degree programs to add to its already well

established list of programs at under graduate and post graduate degree levels. This has attracted the largest number of students to choose IIMCT in the journey of knowledge and learning. More than 2,150 admissions are an indicator to the confidence of youth in the quality and mission of IIMCT. Our finest 847 pedagogues' has published 235 research papers out of which 163 were in Impact Factor, PMDC and HEC recognized journals. Research is the key to an educational Institute's success and for that matter, hefty financial resources of PKR 6.8 million has been invested this year to optimize the research framework at the University.

Child Development Center was established under Riphah College of Rehabilitation Sciences (RCRS) in 2011 as an independent department for learning and development of children with different abilities.

Child development centre is the only centre in the twin cities to provide a balanced, structured programme of learning which will allow every child to progress at his or her own pace while ensuring equal opportunities for all. Along with the guidance from foreign qualified professionals, prominent Pediatricians, Clinicians, Physical Therapists, Speech Pathologists and Occupational Therapists are also on CDC panel.

At CDC parents are encouraged to take full part in their child's progress by attending formal reviews, regular parent-teacher meetings and an open invitation to contact the center at any time to discuss any concerns regarding their child's education or any matter concerning the care and welfare of their child.

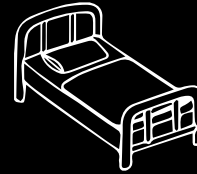




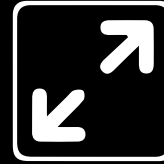

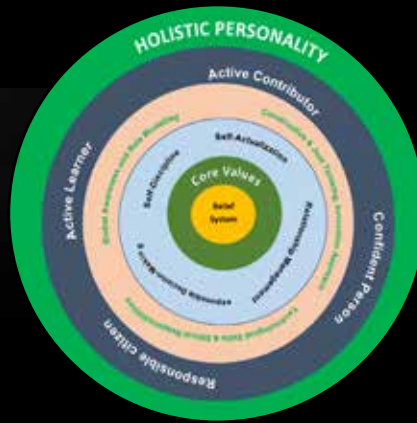

### Fifth ICME 2018

Riphah International University Pakistan and RAK College of Dental Sciences (RAKCODS), Ras al Khaimah jointly organized International Conference on Medical Education and Ottawa Conference (OTTAWA ICME 2018), at Abu Dhabi, UAE from 10th-14th March, 2018 with the partnership of renowned institutions of UAE including UAE University, Gulf Medical University and RAK Medical & Health Sciences University. The event was orchestrated with the support of Abu Dhabi Convention Bureau, Emirates Nursing Association, University of Sharjah and Centre of Excellence in Leadership and Quality (CLIQ) at RAKCODS, UAE. The event was endorsed by Ministry of Health and Prevention, United Arab Emirates. This was the 18th Ottawa Conference and 5th International Conference on Medical Education (ICME 2018).

Sheikh Nahayan Mabarak Al Nahayan, Cabinet Member, Minister of Culture and Knowledge Development was the chief guest at the inaugural session held at Abu Dhabi National Exhibition Center (ADNEC), Abu Dhabi, UAE.

The event was the largest ever gathering in United Arab Emirates in the field of Medical Education. Over 1000 foreign delegates from more than 56 countries spanning from New Zealand in the East to Argentina in the West and Canada in the North to South Africa in the south conducted a record 225 educational sessions, lectures and presentations by over 500 speakers, ranging from courses, workshops, symposia, expert discussions and plenary sessions. Almost all GCC countries actively participated in the conference.

Mr. Hassan Muhammad Khan, Chancellor, Riphah International University and Founder of ICME, said on the occasion; "I am delighted to see that our efforts to establish a credible platform for interaction between world leading medical educationists and those from countries on the path of introducing reforms in medical education in the region, has resulted in such a prestigious





gathering of world leading experts in the wonderful City of Abu Dhabi.

An exhibition held at the joint conference also played a pivotal role in bringing all the related industries together with some of the most important & influential decision-makers in the region. The program was comprised of two days of pre-conference courses, workshops and two and a half days of oral and poster presentations.

30 pre-conference workshops and 4 courses including famous FAME and ESME course were held on the first two days of the conference. The joint conference was enriched with 15 keynote speakers, of whom four are winners of the most prestigious Kerolinska Prize on Research in Medical Education. The mammoth event comprised of 4 plenary sessions, 10 symposia, 6 'what the experts say' sessions and over 60 sessions of oral presentations, conference workshops and poster presentations. The conference had 29 CME credit hours from EACCME - European Accreditation Council on CME marking this as the largest ever medical education conference to take place in the region.

## 2nd International Conference on Recent Innovation in Pharmaceutical Sciences - 2017



Riphah Institute of Pharmaceutical Sciences organized a two day International Conference on "Recent Innovation in Pharmaceutical Sciences" 2017 at Hotel Margala Islamabad. This was the 2nd International Conference on the subject.

Renowned Pakistani nuclear physicist Dr. Abdul Qadeer Khan was the chief guest on the inaugural session. Prof. Dr. Mukhtar Ahmed, Chairman, Higher Education Commission (HEC), Dr. Muhammad Aslam, CEO Drug Regulatory Authority of Pakistan (DRAP), Dr. Anwar ul Hassan Gillani, Chairman Pakistan Council for Science & Technology (PCST) was the guests of honor on the occasion.

In his speech, Dr. Abdul Qadeer Khan emphasized on taking effective steps to eradicate the menace of fake medicines being supplied in the market. He particularly called upon the Drug Regulatory Authority of Pakistan (DRAP) to enforce effective

measures to control the fake medicines. He added that Innovation is the part of education and our aim should be to benefit the mankind from these advancements. It is the responsibility of faculty members to spread knowledge with the aim to serve the country as Pakistan need's experts in every walk of life.

The inaugural session was attended by more than 500 health and medical professionals, regulators, academicians, clinicians, researchers and students. 35 oral talks, 50 scientific posters and 2 workshops were Included in the conference.





## 2nd International Conference on Patient Safety

2<sup>nd</sup> International Conference on Patient Safety 2017, organized by Riphah Institute of Healthcare Improvement & Safety (RIHIS) and hosted by Agha Khan University Hospital, Karachi called for giving high priority to the "Patient Safety" as per constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan and International health & Patient safety standards.
