IIMCT has come a long way since its inception in 1995, towards its mission set by its founder, Late Maj. Gen. (R) Zulfiqar Ali Khan (Sitara Imtiaz). As a pioneering education institution with a strong focus on Islamic ethical values, IIMCT has set new standards for the Higher education in Pakistan.

Now entering in its 24th year of operations, in year 2018-19 IIMCT has seen a transformation in the institution

and has yielded a long list of land mark achievements. We have seen alhamdulillah quantum increase in our admissions and have started 8 new programs. To develop a University Campus which can provide an environment of learning for students IIMCT has bought property more than 100,000m² in Gulberg Greens Islamabad.

Overview Performance Report

Islamic International Medical College Trusts' exponential growth over the past decade is the culmination of excellence in academia as well as its extensive philanthropic endeavors that is being carried out by four fully functional healthcare service providers i.e. IIMCT Pakistan Railways Hospital, Rawalpindi, administered since 1998, Riphah International Hospital, established 2014, Islamic International Dental Hospital, Islamabad, established since 2001 and Max Health Hospital, Islamabad, started its operations in 2016. The year 2018-19 has seen IIMCT engaged in more than 36 free medical camps countrywide with over 12,700 deserving patients being treated by our dedicated team of doctors.

The spirit of philanthropy and humanitarianism at IIMCT has been the hallmark of its achievements in the year 2018-19. By the grace of Almighty Allah, the contribution of Trust in healthcare provision for the year has benefited almost 409,347 patients providing access to a wide range of healthcare services at highly subsidized rates to poor population. Trust spent PKR 332.2 million as healthcare subsidy to these hospitals.

With a vision to create a caring and integrated system of social development services that facilitates human development and helps to improve the quality of life, Riphah Social Welfare Department (RSWD) has

organized 36 free medical camps treating almost 12,700 patients. The third phase of Gen. (R) Zulfiqar Ali Khan Tharparker relief project has been initiated by virtue of which 12 wells has been constructed so far in 2018. To create awareness regarding healthcare and disaster preparedness, a number of awareness sessions has been conducted. IIMCT spent PKR 16.4 million on medical camps, provision of food, water and livelihood to underprivileged and poverty stricken communities in Islamabad KPK and Tkarparkar Sindh.

To enhance the healthcare services paraphernalia, new hospital bed sets have been imported to IIMCT-Pakistan Railway Hospital to cater for the needs of maximum patients. Moreover, the establishment of a Rehab Centre in Riphah International Hospital (RIH) and Max Clinics in MaxHealth Hospitals has added considerable value in providing the best service experience through compassionate care in a patient friendly environment.

Expansion plans for IIMCT have led to considerable developments over the past few years. Some of the noticeable developments include the establishment of Swat Campus for which expedited procedures are underway to make it fully operational. Another landmark development concerning the purchase of 211 kanal of land for the purpose of constructing a new campus of Riphah International at Gulberg Greens Islamabad along with the acquisition of 48 kanal of land in the same location for building a new 600 bed hospital serving the greater purpose of quality healthcare.

In 2018-19, IIMCT has worked hard to achieve all its strategic, operational and financial goals. We have over 11,089 enrolled students studying in various disciplines and 1,258 students graduated this year. In year 2018-19,

in pursuance of its mission, IIMCT provided scholarship worth PKR 165.5 million to provide the deserving students access to world class educational programs. IIMCT has to continued to attract meritorious students by offering high quality, accredited programs in a wide array of professional disciplines. In 2018-19 we launched 8 new degree programs to add to its already well established list of programs at under graduate and post graduate degree levels. This has attracted the largest number of students to choose IIMCT in the journey of knowledge and learning. More than 5,947 admissions are an indicator to the confidence of youth in the quality and mission of IIMCT. Our finest 1,066 pedagogues' has published 269 research papers out of which 176 were in Impact Factor, PMDC and HEC recognized journals. Research is the key to an educational Institute's success and for that matter, hefty financial resources of PKR 13.6 million has been invested this year to optimize the research framework at the University.

Our global impact ALHAMDOLILLAH this year has been very extensive. International conferences on Medical Education (OTTAWA-ICME, Abu Dhabi), Rehab, Pharmacy & Patient Safety has created ripples around the globe.

From an academic perspective, recent certifications, accreditations and associations with World Confederation of Physical Therapy, Washington Accord, American Veterinary Medical Colleges and Pakistan Centre for Philanthropy bears testimony to the vision of Late Maj. Gen. Zulfiqar Ali Khan, the founder of IIMCT.

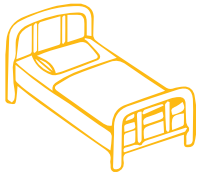

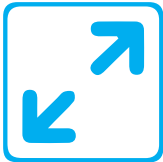

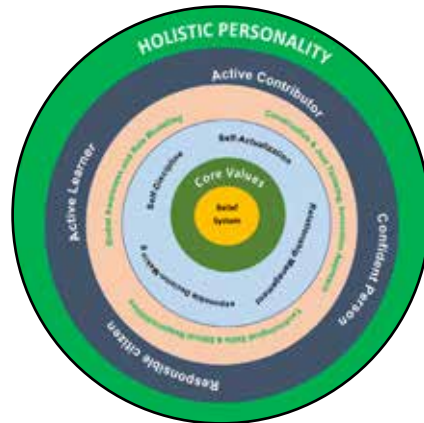

Seminars, Workshops & CONFERENCES

INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON MEDICAL EDUCATION (ICME)

Riphah International University is one of the pioneers in commencing reforms in Medical Education. The aim of ICME conference is to establish a forum for sharing the experiences in healthcare profession education and by bringing together the individuals and organizations both from developed and developing countries.

Riphah International University Pakistan and RAK College of Dental Sciences (RAKCODS), Ras al Khaimah jointly organized International Conference on Medical Education and Ottawa Conference (OTTAWA ICME 2018), at Abu Dhabi, UAE from 10th-14th March, 2018 with the partnership of renowned institutions of UAE including UAE University, Gulf Medical University and RAK Medical & Health Sciences University. The event was orchestrated with the support of Abu Dhabi Convention Bureau, Emirates Nursing Association, University of Sharjah and Centre of Excellence in Leadership and Quality (CLIQ) at RAKCODS, UAE. The event was endorsed by Ministry of Health and Prevention, United Arab Emirates. This was the 18th Ottawa Conference and 5th International Conference on Medical Education (ICME 2018).

Sheikh Nahayan Mabarak Al Nahayan, Cabinet Member, Minister of Culture and Knowledge Development was the chief guest at the inaugural session held at Abu Dhabi National Exhibition Center (ADNEC), Abu Dhabi, UAE.

The event was the largest ever gathering in United Arab Emirates in the field of Medical Education. Over 1000 foreign delegates from more than 56 countries spanning from New Zealand in the East to Argentina in the West and Canada in the North to South Africa in the south conducted a record 225 educational sessions, lectures and presentations by over 500 speakers, ranging from courses, workshops, symposia, expert discussions and plenary sessions. Almost



all GCC countries actively participated in the conference.

Mr. Hassan Muhammad Khan, Chancellor, Riphah International University and Founder of ICME, said on the occasion; "I am delighted to see that our efforts to establish a credible platform for interaction between world leading medical educationists and those from countries on the path of introducing reforms in medical education in the region, has resulted in such a prestigious gathering of world leading experts in the wonderful City of Abu Dhabi.

An exhibition held at the joint conference also played a pivotal role in bringing all the related industries together with some of the most important & influential decision-makers in the region. The program was comprised of two days of pre-conference courses, workshops and two and a half days of oral and poster presentations.

30 pre-conference workshops and 4 courses including famous FAME and ESME course were held on the first two days of the conference. The joint conference was enriched with 15 keynote speakers, of whom four are winners of the most prestigious Kerolinska Prize on Research in Medical Education. The mammoth event comprised of 4 plenary sessions, 10 symposia, 6 'what the experts say' sessions

and over 60 sessions of oral presentations, conference workshops and poster presentations. The conference had 29 CME credit hours from EACCME - European Accreditation Council on CME marking this as the largest ever medical education conference to take place in the region.

3RD INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON RECENT INNOVATION IN PHARMACEUTICAL SCIENCES - 2017

The 3rd International Conference on recent innovations in pharmaceutical sciences ICRIPS 2019 organized by Faculty of Pharmaceutical Sciences held at Margalla Hotel, Islamabad. The inauguration session was started with the recitation of Holy Quran. The ceremony was honored by the presence of chief guest Prof. Dr. Muhammad Ali, Vice Chancellor, Quaid-i-Azam University, Islamabad, guest of honor Prof. Dr. Ghulam Raza Bhatti, Member operations and planning, HEC, Islamabad and Chancellor Riphah International University, Mr. Hassan Muhammad Khan.

While addressing, Prof. Dr. Muhammad Ali emphasized on research output in country whereas Prof. Dr. Ghulam Raza Bhatti talked about HEC policies regarding research and liaison with research institutes. The chancellor RIU, Mr. Hassan Muhammad Khan emphasized on applied research with specific focus to decrease the disease burden of our country.

There were 33 oral presentations including international and national speakers and 52 posters presenters comprising of both graduates and undergraduate students from different universities around the country.



Three workshops on Pharmacogenomics, Bioinformatics and Pharmacy practice were held on first and second days. The oral talks covered majority of the sections and topics related to pharmaceutical innovation and research, namely, drug discovery and development, emerging trends in nano medicine, natural products and pharmaceutical analysis. The poster competition winners were also awarded with certificates and cash prizes.

3RD INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON PATIENT SAFETY

3rd International Conference on Patient Safety 2018, was organized by Riphah Institute of Healthcare Improvement & Safety (RIHIS), in collaboration with CMH Lahore Medical College and School of Dentistry, Lahore. The theme of the conference was "From Knowledge To Improvement". It adopted Lahore declaration calling for giving high priority to the "Patient Safety" as per constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan and International Health & Patient Safety standards.

The Conference was inaugurated by Dr. Nausheen Hamid - Federal Parliamentary Secretary, National Health Services. She said that Federal Government will help provinces in improving the health facilities. She added that Federal institutions, along with the provincial governments helping in providing better health facilities. The Director General Ministry of Health Dr. Assad Hafeez said that the Ministry of Health will soon be launching a working group for Patient Safety. Dr. Amjad Saqib-Founder, Akhuwat Foundation & Board Member, Punjab Healthcare Commission highlighted the importance of Patient focus in medical care. Dr. Muhammad Ajmal Khan -CEO, Punjab Healthcare Commission shared the commitment and journey of PHC in the roll out of MSDS as a mandatory requirement for all healthcare facilities in the province. DGMS (Navy) Maj General Qamarul Haq and General Naeem Naqi endorsed the commitment of the armed forces medical corps in developing a culture of patient safety. Earlier, Chancellor Riphah International University Mr. Hassan Muhammad Khan welcomed

the participants of the conference and hoped the conference will help in developing a learning network of health care professionals on patient safety and quality of healthcare. He said Riphah intends to closely align its health professions curriculum, both at graduate and postgraduate levels, with patient safety as one of the key objectives. The Chairman of the ICPS and Project Director of RIHIS, Dr. Zakiuddin Ahmed highlighted the importance of patient safety in Pakistan.

The International Conference was attended by the national and international experts from United States, Turkey, Malaysia, Australia and many other parts of the world as well as heads and chiefs of various regulatory bodies, government functionaries, medical directors of country's leading hospitals, pharmaceutical sector representatives, academicians, doctors and paramedics.

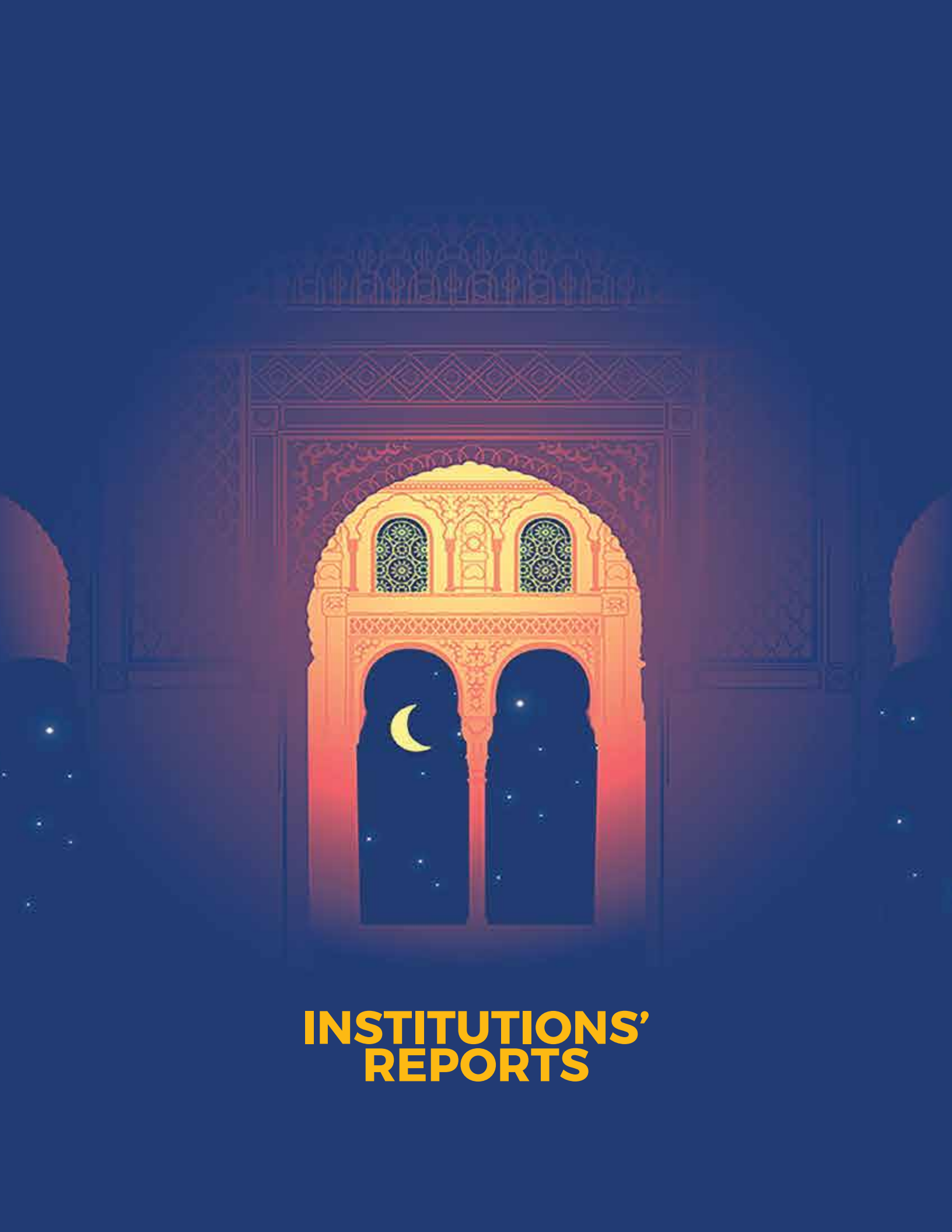

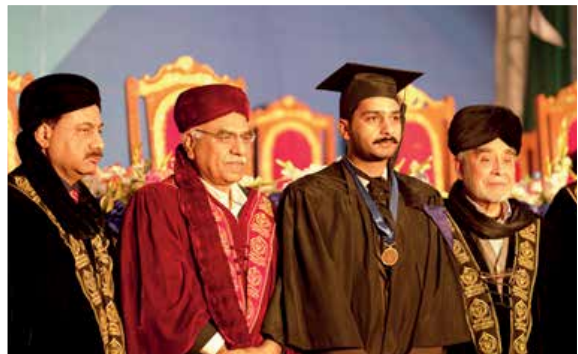

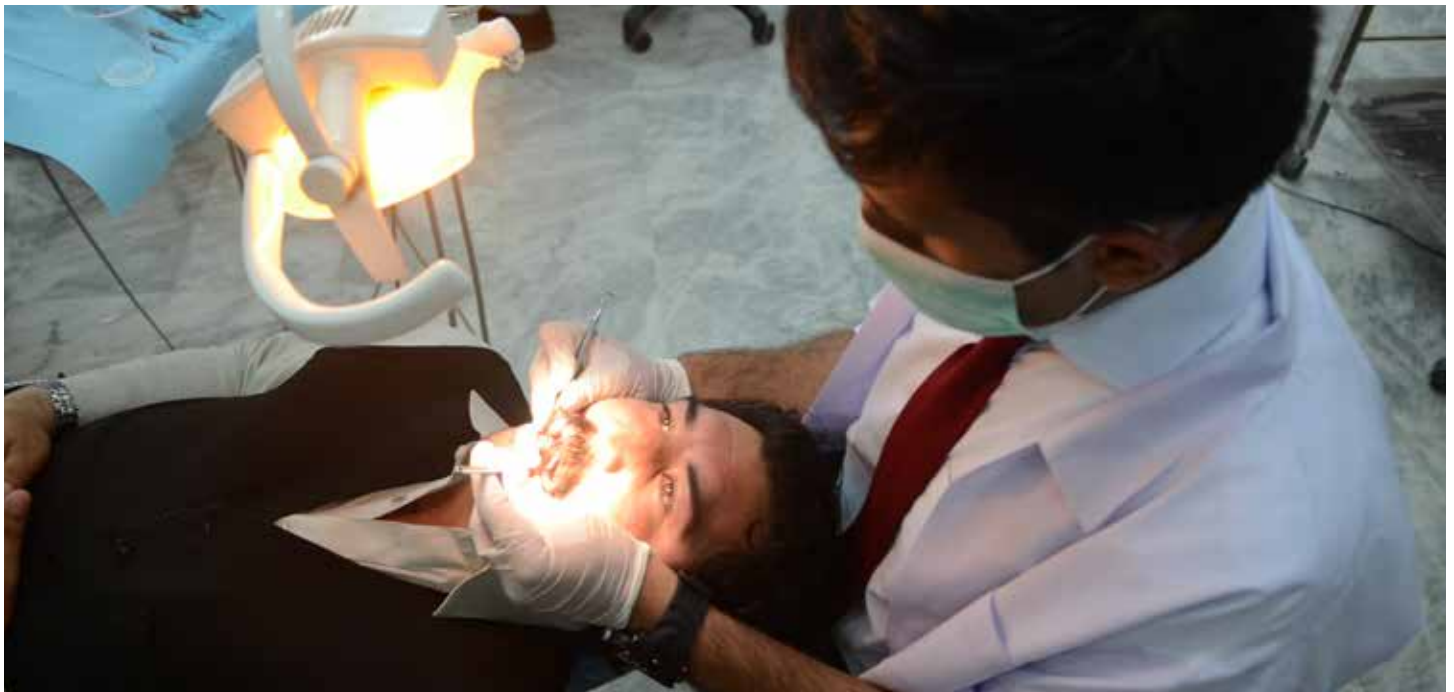
