

IIMCT has come a long way since its inception in 1995, towards its mission set by its founder, Late Maj. Gen. (R) Zulfiqar Ali Khan (Sitara Imtiaz). As a pioneering education institution with a strong focus on Islamic ethical values, IIMCT has set new standards for the Higher education in Pakistan.

Now entering in its 24th year of operations, in year 2019-20 IIMCT has seen a transformation in the

institution and has yielded a long list of land mark achievements. We have seen alhamdulillah quantum increase in our admissions and have started 12 new programs. To develop a University Campus which can provide an environment of learning for students IIMCT has bought property more than 100,000m² in Gulberg Greens Islamabad.

Overview Performance Report

Islamic International Medical College Trusts' exponential growth over the past decade is the culmination of excellence in academia as well as its extensive philanthropic endeavors that is being carried out by four fully functional healthcare service providers i.e. IIMCT Pakistan Railways Hospital, Rawalpindi, administered since 1998, Riphah International Hospital, established 2014, Islamic International Dental Hospital, Islamabad, established since 2001 and Max Health Hospital, Islamabad, started its operations in 2016. The year 2019-20 has seen IIMCT engaged in more than 27 free medical camps countrywide with over 10,000 deserving patients being treated by our dedicated team of doctors.

The spirit of philanthropy and humanitarianism at IIMCT has been the hallmark of its achievements in the year 2019-20. By the grace of Almighty Allah, the contribution of Trust in healthcare provision for the year has benefited almost 347,176 patients providing access to a wide range of healthcare services at highly subsidized rates to poor population. Trust spent PKR 428.6 million as healthcare subsidy to these hospitals.

With a vision to create a caring and integrated system of social development services that facilitates human development and helps to improve the quality of life, Riphah Social Welfare Department (RSWD) has organized 27 free medical camps treating almost 10,000 patients. The third phase of Gen. (R) Zulfiqar Ali Khan Tharparker relief project has been initiated by virtue of which 27 wells has been constructed so far in 2020. To create awareness regarding healthcare and disaster preparedness, a number of awareness sessions has been conducted. IIMCT spent PKR 18.8 million on medical camps, provision of food, water and livelihood to underprivileged and poverty striken communities in Islamabad KPK and Tkarparkar Sindh and other welfare activities.

To enhance the healthcare services paraphernalia, new hospital bed sets have been imported to IIMCT-Pakistan Railway Hospital to cater for the needs of maximum patients. Moreover, the establishment of a Rehab Centre in Riphah International Hospital (RIH) and Max Clinics in MaxHealth Hospitals has added considerable value in providing the best service experience through compassionate care in a patient friendly environment.

Expansion plans for IIMCT have led to considerable developments over the past few years. Some of the noticeable developments include the establishment of Swat Campus for which expedited procedures are underway to make it fully operational. Another landmark development concerning the purchase of 211 kanal of land for the purpose of constructing a new campus of Riphah International University at Gulberg Greens Islamabad along with the acquisition of 48 kanal of land in the same location for building a new 600 bed hospital serving the greater purpose of quality healthcare.

In 2019-20, IIMCT has worked hard to achieve all its strategic, operational and financial goals. We have over 7,742 enrolled students studying in various disciplines and 1,120 students graduated this year. In year 2019-20,

in pursuance of its mission, IIMCT provided scholarship worth PKR 149.8 million to provide the deserving students access to world class educational programs. IIMCT has to continued to attract meritous students by offering high quality, accredited programs in a wide array of professional disciplines. In 2019-20 we launched 12 new degree programs to add to its already well established list of programs at under graduate and post graduate degree levels. This has attracted the largest number of students to choose IIMCT in the journey of knowledge and learning. More than 4,801 admissions are an indicator to the confidence of youth in the quality and mission of IIMCT. Our finest 1,066 pedagogues' has published 321 research papers out of which 258 were in Impact Factor, PMDC and HEC recognized journals. Research is the key to an educational Institute's success and for that matter, hefty financial resources of PKR 17.3 million has been invested this year to optimize the research framework at the University.

Our global impact ALHAMDOLILLAH this year has been very extensive. International conferences on Medical Education (OTTAWA-ICME, Abu Dhabi), Rehab, Pharmacy & Patient Safety has created ripples around the globe.

From an academic perspective, recent certifications, accreditations and associations with World Confederation of Physical Therapy, Washington Accord, American Veterinary Medical Colleges and Pakistan Centre for Philanthropy bears testimony to the vision of Late Maj. Gen. Zulfiqar Ali Khan, the founder of IIMCT.





INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON MEDICAL EDUCATION (ICME)

Riphah International University is one of the pioneers in commencing reforms in Medical Education. The aim of ICME conference is to establish a forum for sharing the experiences in healthcare profession education and by bringing together the individuals and organizations both from developed and developing countries.

Fifth ICME 2019

Sixth International Conference on Medical Education was organized from 19-22 October 2019, in Islamabad Pakistan. It was second occasion, after the first ICME in 2009, that the conference was organized in Islamabad after ten years. By now ICME has increased its scope and includes other branches of Health Profession (Dental, Nursing, Rehabilitation Medicine and Pharmacy) as well. For this reason selected theme of the conference was "21st Century Challenges in Health Professions Education".

The conference was organized in academic partnership with Army Medical College, Fazaia Medical College, Foundation University, Rawalpindi Medical University, Tameer-i-Millat University, University of Lahore, Dow Medical University and Jinnah Sind Medical University. It was supported by Association for Medical Education in Europe (AMEE), Society of Medical Educationists (Pakistan), International Federation of Medical Students' Association and Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Edinburgh. The conference was patronized by Higher Education Commission of Pakistan and Pakistan Science Foundation.

The main objectives of the 6th conference included:

1. To discuss internal and external challenges confronted by Health Profession Education

both nationally and internationally.

- 2. Sharing the challenges imposed by societal issues, social accountability, accreditation standards and healthcare reforms.
- 3. Discussion on standards for medical schools, defined outcomes, inculcation of ethical values, and methods of assessment for 21st Century.
- 4. Faculty development and promotion of scholarship of teaching to maintain excellence in health profession education.

Main topics selected included Students Assessment, Islamic Ethics, Continuing Professional Development, Interprofessional Education, Patient safety, Professionalism and Integrity, Curriculum Viability, Student Selection, Educational Leadership, Empowering Learners, Accreditation Standards, Artificial Intelligence, Simulation and Educational Research.


The event comprised two days of Pre-Conference courses and workshops and two days of main conference. Pre-Conference Courses and Workshops were conducted at three campuses of Riphah International University and campuses of partners institutions on 19th and 20th October while main conference was held at Pak-China Friendship Center on 21st and 22nd October. In all four courses and thirty PCW were conducted. Courses were conducted on Educational Leadership, Research in Health Profession ICME 2021 Excellence in Health Profession Education; Through Globalization లా Collaboration











Education, Developing an Online Course and Understanding Entrustable Professional Activities. PCWs covered a wide range of hot topics in Health Profession Education and included subjects like Mentoring, Artificial Intelligence, Simulated Patients and Time Management. There were total of 39 International and National Experts who conducted these courses and workshops. International speakers came from USA, UK, Netherlands, UAE, KSA, Iran and Vietnam whereas national speakers came from almost all parts of Pakistan.

Total of 267 abstracts were received from national and international presenters. Of these 242 were accepted while 213 registered. Abstracts were divided into 19 sessions of oral presentations, 5 sessions of poster presentations and 10 free conference workshops. In addition, there were two Plenaries, five Symposia and five sessions of What the Experts say? sessions on various topics of current interest. Plenaries were delivered by Prof Olle ten Cate from Netherland, Prof Brownel Anderson from USA, Prof Hossam Hamdi from UAE and Prof Ronald Harden. Prof Ronald Harden, who was not allowed to travel by his doctors sent his recorded plenary that was run as first plenary lecture.

3RD INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON RECENT INNOVATION IN PHARMACEUTICAL SCIENCES - 2019

The 3rd International Conference on recent innovations in pharmaceutical sciences ICRIPS 2019 organized by Faculty of Pharmaceutical Sciences held at Margalla Hotel, Islamabad. The inauguration session was started with the recitation of Holy Quran. The ceremony was honored by the presence of chief guest Prof. Dr. Muhammad Ali, Vice Chancellor, Quaid-i-Azam University, Islamabad, guest of honor Prof. Dr. Ghulam Raza Bhatti, Member operations and planning, HEC, Islamabad and Chancellor Riphah International University, Mr. Hassan Muhammad Khan.

While addressing, Prof. Dr. Muhammad Ali emphasized on research output in country whereas Prof. Dr. Ghulam Raza Bhatti talked about HEC policies regarding research and liaison with research institutes. The chancellor RIU, Mr. Hassan Muhammad Khan emphasized on applied research with specific focus to decrease thedisease burden of our country.

There were 33 oral presentations including international and national speakersand 52 posterspresenters comprising of both graduates and undergraduate students from different universities around the country. Three workshops on Pharmacogenomics, Bioinformatics and Pharmacy practice were held on first and second days. The oral talks covered majority of the sections and topics related to pharmaceutical innovation and research, namely, drug discovery and development, emerging trends in nano medicine, natural products and pharmaceutical analysis. The poster competition winners were also awarded with certificates and cash prizes.



4th International Conference on Patient Safety 2019

Special Assistant to Prime Minister on Health Dr. Zafar Mirza said the "unholv alliance between medical professionals and the medical industry" is responsible for endangering the lives of patients in Pakistan. This nexus needs to be broken without further delay if the interests of patients are to be safeguarded, while speaking at the inaugural ceremony of the 4th International Conference on Patient Safety. "On the one hand, unlicensed medical practitioners or guacks are playing with the lives of people, and on the other, gualified practitioners are receiving unethical sponsorships and prescribing wrong medicines to patients," Dr. Zafar pointed out at the conference, which has been organized by Riphah International University and Riphah Institute of Healthcare Improvement and Safety, in collaboration with the Institute of Leadership Excellence (ILE) and Rawalpindi Medical University.

Earlier, in his keynote address, international patient safety expert from Wayne State University, US, Prof. Dr. Paul Barach said spending more money on healthcare will not solve the issue of patient safety, and called for spending more on leadership in healthcare and changing the existing culture in health facilities to ensure patient wellbeing.

Another international expert from Usher Institute, University of Edinburg, Prof. Dr. Aziz Shaikh, called for enhancing health literacy, use of technology, and increasing patientdoctor interaction to reduce chances of medical negligence. Chairman ICPS & Director Riphah Institute of Healthcare Improvement & Safety Dr. Zakiuddin Ahmed called for developing healthcare professionals as leaders and informed that said they have established Institute of Leadership Excellence as a CSR activity that would train healthcare professionals and physicians to ensure patient safety. The Vice Chancellor Rawalpindi Medical University Prof. Dr. Muhammad Umar, speaking on the occasion, appreciated Riphah international university for initiating patient safety system by organizing the 4th International conference on the subject in Pakistan. He particularly congratulated and appreciated (Late) Maj Gen. Zulfigar Ali khan for his service to nation in field of cardiology and founding Islamic International Medical College Trust



2nd International Conference on Rehabilitation Sciences

2nd International Conference on Rehabilitation Sciences organized by College of Rehabilitation & Allied Health Sciences (RCRAHS), a constituent institute of Riphah International University, Islamabad. The theme of conference was "Challenges in specialized & autonomous practice in rehabilitation Sciences". Executive Director Higher Education Commission, Dr. Arshad Ali was the chief Guest of the closing ceremony of the conference. In this mega event Riphah Faisalabad campus, Margalla Institute of Health Sciences, Helping Hand Institute of Rehabilitation Sciences, Rehman Institute of Rehab Sciences, NCS university system, Shifa Tameer-e-Millat University and the Physio Multan participated and placed their Stalls for information.

The key note speakers from across the world included Professor Cornelia Kulig from the University of Southern California USA, Professor Jenifer Keating, from Monash University Australia, Professor Denise Taylor, Dr. Nada Signal, Dr. Imran Niazi from Auckland University of technology, Associate Professor Shane Patman from the University of Notre Dame Australia, Patricia MacLoughlin from St Patrick Hospital Ireland, Professor Ulrika Löfkvist from the University of Oslo, Sweden. Along with the international key-note speakers 12 national experts delivered their speeches on the key issues and aspects of the rehabilitation profession in the local and global perspectives. 20 workshops were held on various topics of professional interest of rehab and 76 scientific research papers presented by rehab professionals form different public and private sector universities during the conference.



14TH CONVOCATION

Prominent nuclear scientist Dr Abdul Qadir khan has said that the nuclear team of Atomic Energy Commission had successfully prepared the atomic bomb in December 1984 and subsequently its delivery system which had averted many wars and had made Pakistan so strong that no power on earth could caste an evil eye on it. He was addressing the 14th convocation of Riphah International University here at Jinnah Convention Centre today.

He advised the graduating students to work with devotion, sincerity and enthusiasm for the service of the humanity and regularly observe the teachings of Islam which would ensure gaining of material gains as well as success in hereafter.

During his speech, Dr Abdul Qadeer Khan narrated incidents of his student's life and higher education, he gained at Germany and Holland. He said that while studying abroad he was always mindful that whatever knowledge he was gaining would be utilized for betterment of his country. He also distributed Zulfiqar Gold medals and Chancellor Gold Medals among the top scorers of various subjects.

Earlier, Dr Anis Ahmad, Vice Chancellor of Riphah International University briefly narrated the history of the university. He told that the university was started in 1996 with very meagre resources with induction of 72 students in Medical college but now there were 117 programmes, offered by various departments of the university and about 16,000 students were enrolled. The University has been ranked at second position by Higher Education Commission recently in general category among ninety private universities of Pakistan.

Chancellor Riphah International University, Hassan Muhammed Khan recalled the reminiscences of founder of the university, Major General (Retired) Zulfiqar Ali Khan. He had gone to UK for higher education in cardiology and was offered a lucrative job, but he returned to Pakistan and joined the Army as a Major. He worked in a small room with a view to establish state of the art Cardiology Institute and succeeded. After retirement, he established the present medical college which has flourished to an International university with campuses at Islamabad, Rawalpindi, Faisalabad, Lahore, Swat and a Dental College at Rasul Khema, UAE. He paid rich tributes to Dr Abdul Qadeer khan and advised the students to follow his footsteps in dedication, sincerity and gaining knowledge. About five hundred healers were added to the service of the humanity, when they graduated at the 14th Convocation of Riphah International University today. They included allopathic doctors, dentists, psychologists, physiotherapists and pharmaceutics. On the occasion, they pledged to serve the humanity with sincerity without distinction of race, colour and religion. The convocation was attended by a large number of students, their parents, teachers and a large number of guests.

RIPS was established in 2004 with state of the art labs fully equipped with modern equipment/facilities and a model Hospital Pharmacy in our affiliated Railway Hospital offering 5 year Doctor of Pharmacy program.

Exactly after 5 years in 2009, we were rated as the "best" amongst both the public and private sector institutions by the Pharmacy Council of Pakistan. We were the first to implement the International Code of Good Laboratory Practices. Soon after that RIPS was put on the WHO list of affiliated institutions.

The 3rd International Conference on recent innovations in pharmaceutical sciences ICRIPS 2019 organized by Faculty of Pharmaceutical Sciences held at Margalla Hotel, Islamabad with the call to produce cheaper quality medicines that are affordable to every common man of the country. RCRS is pioneer of Doctor of Physical therapy program (DPT) and Post Professional Doctor of Physical Therapy program (PP-DPT) in Pakistan (Equivalency of 18 years of schooling/M.Phil as per HEC criteria). Our DPT is the first entry level physical therapy program in Pakistan accredited by WCPT in the whole south Asia. By virtue of this Riphah graduates will be benefited in 111 member countries of WCPT for higher studies and employment opportunities. 





RSWD in collaboration with City Traffic Police Rawalpindi, Pakistan National Heart Association (PANAH) and Rescue 1122 organized different seminars/lectures and walks on social issues.

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Training of Rescue 1122:

With the vision that safe communities where all citizens are provided the right to timely emergency response and care without discrimination, Riphah social welfare department collaboration with rescue 1122 conducted various training on basic life skill (BLS) and fire safety. Numbers of trainings were organized by RSWD in different campuses of Riphah University.

BLS in general stands for Basic Life Support. It denotes a level of care that patients will receive in an emergency situation in a wide variety of settings including in-hospital and out of hospital. The training course help healthcare professionals gain the ability to recognize various life-threatening emergencies, perform CPR, use AED and relieve chocking in a safe, timely and effective manner.

CPR is a life-saving technique that is used when someone's heart has stopped. Some medical conditions, such as a severe heart attack, can cause the heart to stop. Other causes include drowning, electric shock, poisoning, overdose and serious injury. For CPR to be successful, it needs to be started as soon as possible after a person's heart stops.

The expert trainers of Rescue 1122 shared very important and detailed information during these sessions.

Tree plantation campaign:

Tree plantation campaigns were organized by Riphah Social Welfare Department (RSWD) in collaboration with Riphah International University I-14 campus and Riphah International Hospital as per need of the country which is suffering by water scarcity.

In these campaigns, Vice Chancellor, Deputy Vice Chancellor and MS RIH actively participated in planting about 100 saplings. During the planting campaign VC expressed his thoughts by saying that there is dire need of plantation in Pakistan and best Sadka Jariya. He further said that this is the great achievement of RSWD and all should fully participate in this campaign.

Tharparkar relief project phase IV:

Tharparker is a district of Sindh province has the lowest Human Development Index among all districts of the province. The most of population of the area use to speak with each other in "Dhatki", the local language since many decades. People can't cultivate crops on their lands as there is desert everywhere. Local population use to wait for monsoon rains which occur for their bread and butter.

RIPHAH Social Welfare Department (RSWD) team provided relief to the drought-affected people of Tharparkar, under the supervision of Dr. Azhar Halim (Director RSWD). The team was given following targets;

- Free Medical Camps.
- Distribution of ration
- Distribution of Livestock.
- School Project
- Kitchen gardening
- 1. Free Medical Camps- 15 Doctors team of IIMCT organized Medical Camps in various far flung areas of Tharparkar. More than 4000 patients were provided free medical checkups along with medicines.
- 2. Distributed 250 Food Packages (One month quota) which contained (Pulses, Ghee, Oatmeal, Tea, Baby Milk, Rice and sugar) to the deserving families, facilities.
- 3. RIPHAH team purchased 140 goats; Livestock the aim of category was to fulfill the need of milk of malnourished children. Goats were distributed in 140 families of different villages for their income sources as well.
- Looking at deteriorated situation of education in the areas, Riphah Initiated to repair and renovate the poor building of school in village Bhagliar, Tehsil Diplo.
- 5. IIMCT initiated agriculture program in Tharparkar in phase IV. Under this program, people are encouraged and given facilities to cultivate vegetables on household level. Besides fulfilling their domestic requirements, they earn a fair amount of money by selling their production in nearby markets.
 - Beside these, medicines and some equipment for District Hospital NICU were also provided. Repairing and maintenance of mosques was done.
 - Previously built water resources were visited which were providing water for communities. Some new wells and water bores were also initiative during this trip by Riphah Philanthropists friends.

- Especially widows and Orphans were provided with cash amounts.
- RSWD Constructed of 10 handpumps in Thar villages for drinking.

Fund raising for affected community from Covid-19:

Coronavirus threatens everyone's way of life, but it is especially difficult for people who are already vulnerable. Alhamdo Lillah Riphah Social Welfare Department has raised donation campaign in this crucial situation for deserving as well as effected people.

Following are the details:

- 1. A ventilator has been installed in Riphah hospital for corona effected patients.
- 2. Mobile ambulance service has been started in collaboration with Helping Hands.
- 3. Provided PPEs to staff of Riphah Hospitals
- 4. More than 500 hundred bags of ration have been distributed among deprived people in local community as well as in Tharparkar.
- 5. More than one million rupees (Zakat and Sadqa) has been distributed among deserving and needy population.
- 6. Constructed water wells and hand pumps in Tharparkar
- 7. Donated equipment of Physiotherapy to PRH
- 8. Donated oxygen concentrator to a poor widow
- 9. Provided wheelchairs to disable persons
- 10. Provide clean drinking water cooler to Madrasa in Pirwadhai, Rawalpindi
- 11. For awareness regarding prevention of coronavirus banners and other printing materials has been distributed and Mosques and other public places.



















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
